Health Accounts

(2005 - 2007)¹

In 2006, Current Expenditure in Health continues to slow down, as in the previous year and in 2007 it is estimated that an acceleration has been recorded

In 2006, total current expenditure in health increased 2,3% (5,4% in 2005), in nominal terms, and represented 9,5% of GDP, at market prices. In 2007, the change rate of current expenditure in health has increased and it is estimated that in nominal terms the change rate was 3.5%.
